Applicants will be selected on a competitive basis through an evaluation of submitted applications and other supporting documents. **Travel Awards (airfare and accommodation) will be available to the top 15 qualified candidates. Candidates who qualify to receive a travel award will be required to pay a processing fee of USD \$250.00**

Supporting documents:

- Updated CV to include your research interests, positions, honours, awards and past research projects (no more than two-pages).
- A statement of support from the applicant's Program Supervisor, Department Head and/or Research Collaborator on institutional letterhead.
- Concept Note (2-3 pages) giving details of a research project that addresses the problem of Non-Communicable Diseases in the region. The concept note should include the following:
 - Purpose of the research
 - Dissemination and Implementation research goals/objectives
 - Primary research question/hypothesis
 - Brief research methods
 - Relevance to the mission of the funding agency
